5 WHEREAS, Bill Hansen was born in rural Hebron to Lawrence 6 and Hilma (Anderson) Hansen on March 14, 1937; his family moved 7 to a farm near Richmond when he was nine and he attended school 8 in Hebron, graduating from Alden-Hebron High School in 1955; he 9 was a member of the junior varsity basketball team when the 10 Hebron Giants won the state championship; he was a member of 4-H, the baseball team, the student council, the yearbook 11 12 staff, and the Future Farmers of America both as a member and 13 president; he was crowned junior prom king in 1954; he married 14 Carol Mae Hoffman at Genoa City, Wisconsin on February 10, 15 1973; and

16 WHEREAS, Bill Hansen attended the University of Illinois, 17 taking courses in farming; he farmed in the area all his life; 18 he was a member of the McHenry County Farm Bureau and looked 19 forward to the times he cooked hamburgers at the fair for the 20 Farm Bureau Food Stand; and
