WHEREAS, Bob Cheffer began his career at Alexander Lumber and Joliet Federal Savings and Loan; he then moved to the Quad Cities in 1983; he was President of Rock Island Federal Savings and Loan and later Vice President at Metrobank in East Moline; he was a real estate appraiser early in his banking career and also during his retirement, when he had his own appraisal company; and
