1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 188

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 188 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by  
5 changing Section 3-421 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/3-421) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-421)

7 Sec. 3-421. Right of reassignment.

8 (a) Every natural person shall have the right of  
9 reassignment of the license number issued to him during the  
10 current registration plate term, for the ensuing registration  
11 plate term, provided his application for reassignment is  
12 received in the Office of the Secretary of State on or before  
13 September 30 of the final year of the registration plate term  
14 as to a vehicle registered on a calendar year, and on or before  
15 March 31 as to a vehicle registered on a fiscal year. The right  
16 of reassignment shall apply to every natural person under the

1 staggered registration system provided the application for  
2 reassignment is received in the Office of the Secretary of  
3 State by the 1st day of the month immediately preceding the  
4 applicant's month of expiration.

5 In addition, every natural person shall have the right of  
6 reassignment of the license number issued to him for a two-year  
7 registration, for the ensuing two-year period. Where the  
8 two-year period is for two calendar years, the application for  
9 reassignment must be received by the Secretary of State on or  
10 before September 30th of the year preceding commencement of the  
11 two-year period. Where the two-year period is for two fiscal  
12 years commencing on July 1, the application for reassignment  
13 must be received by the Secretary of State on or before April  
14 30th immediately preceding commencement of the two-year  
15 period.

16 (b) Notwithstanding the above provision, the Secretary of  
17 State shall, subject to the existing right of reassignment,  
18 have the authority to designate new specific combinations of  
19 numerical, alpha-numerical, and numerical-alpha licenses for  
20 vehicles registered on a calendar year or on a fiscal year,  
21 whether the license be issued for one or more years. The new  
22 combinations so specified shall not be subject to the right of  
23 reassignment, and no right of reassignment thereto may at any  
24 future time be acquired.

25 (c) If a person has a registration plate in his or her name  
26 and seeks to reassign the registration plate to his or her

1 spouse, the Secretary shall waive any transfer fee or vanity or  
2 personalized registration plate fee upon both spouses signing a  
3 form authorizing the reassignment of registration.

4 (c-1) If a person that has a registration plate in his or  
5 her name seeks to reassign the registration plate to his or her  
6 child, the Secretary shall waive any transfer fee or vanity or  
7 personalized registration plate fee.
