1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 942

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 942 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Illinois Highway Code is amended by  
5 changing Section 6-140 as follows:

6 (605 ILCS 5/6-140)

7 Sec. 6-140. Abolishing a road district within Lake County  
8 or McHenry County with less than 15 miles of roads. Any  
9 township in Lake County or McHenry County shall abolish a road  
10 district of that township if the roads of the road district are  
11 less than 15 centerline miles in length on August 9, 2019, as  
12 determined by the county engineer or county superintendent of  
13 highways. A road district is abolished on the expiration of the  
14 term of office of the highway commissioner of the road district  
15 facing abolition following the determination by the county  
16 engineer or county superintendent of highways of the length, in

1 centerline mileage, of the roads within the road district to be  
2 abolished.

3 On the date of abolition: all the rights, powers, duties,  
4 assets, property, liabilities, obligations, and  
5 responsibilities of the road district shall by operation of law  
6 vest in and be assumed by the township; the township board of  
7 trustees shall assume all taxing authority of a road district  
8 abolished under this Section and shall exercise all duties and  
9 responsibilities of the highway commissioner as provided in  
10 this Code; and for purposes of distribution of revenue, the  
11 township shall assume the powers, duties, and obligations of  
12 the road district. The township board of trustees may enter  
13 into a contract with the county, a municipality, or a private  
14 contractor to administer the roads added to its jurisdiction  
15 under this Section.
