SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

430 ILCS 65/13.1

from Ch. 38, par. 83-13.1

Amends the Firearm Owners Identification Card Act. Provides that a unit of local government, including a home rule unit, may not impose a tax, fee, or other assessment other than the normal sales tax rate for goods on a firearm, firearm attachment, or firearm ammunition. Provides that the provisions of any ordinance or resolution, in effect or adopted, on or after the effective date of the amendatory Act by any unit of local government, including a home rule unit, that imposes a tax, fee, or other assessment other than the normal sales tax rate for goods on a firearm, firearm attachment, or firearm ammunition are invalid and void. Effective immediately.

HOME RULE NOTE ACT MAY APPLY

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning safety.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Firearm Owners Identification Card Act is
amended by changing Section 13.1 as follows:

6 (430 ILCS 65/13.1) (from Ch. 38, par. 83-13.1)

7 Sec. 13.1. Preemption.

8 (a) Except as otherwise provided in the Firearm Concealed 9 Carry Act and subsections (b) and (c) of this Section, the 10 provisions of any ordinance enacted by any municipality which 11 requires registration or imposes greater restrictions or 12 limitations on the acquisition, possession and transfer of 13 firearms than are imposed by this Act, are not invalidated or 14 affected by this Act.

(b) Notwithstanding subsection (a) of this Section, the 15 16 regulation, licensing, possession, and registration of 17 handguns and ammunition for a handgun, and the transportation of any firearm and ammunition by a holder of a valid Firearm 18 Owner's Identification Card issued by the Department of State 19 Police under this Act are exclusive powers and functions of 20 21 this State. Any ordinance or regulation, or portion of that ordinance or regulation, enacted on or before the effective 22 date of this amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly that 23

purports to impose regulations or restrictions on a holder of a 1 2 valid Firearm Owner's Identification Card issued by the Department of State Police under this Act in a manner that is 3 inconsistent with this Act, on the effective date of this 4 5 amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly, shall be invalid in its application to a holder of a valid Firearm Owner's 6 7 Identification Card issued by the Department of State Police 8 under this Act.

9 (c) Notwithstanding subsection (a) of this Section, the 10 regulation of the possession or ownership of assault weapons 11 are exclusive powers and functions of this State. Any ordinance 12 or regulation, or portion of that ordinance or regulation, that purports to regulate the possession or ownership of assault 13 14 weapons in a manner that is inconsistent with this Act, shall 15 be invalid unless the ordinance or regulation is enacted on, 16 before, or within 10 days after the effective date of this 17 amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly. Any ordinance or regulation described in this subsection (c) enacted more than 18 10 days after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 19 98th General Assembly is invalid. An ordinance enacted on, 20 before, or within 10 days after the effective date of this 21 22 amendatory Act of the 98th General Assembly may be amended. The 23 enactment or amendment of ordinances under this subsection (c) are subject to the submission requirements of Section 13.3. For 24 25 the purposes of this subsection, "assault weapons" means 26 firearms designated by either make or model or by a test or

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1 list of cosmetic features that cumulatively would place the 2 firearm into a definition of "assault weapon" under the 3 ordinance.

(c-5) A unit of local government, including a home rule 4 5 unit, may not impose a tax, fee, or other assessment other than the normal sales tax rate for goods on a firearm, firearm 6 7 attachment, or firearm ammunition. The provisions of any 8 ordinance or resolution, in effect or adopted, on or after the 9 effective date of this amendatory Act of the 101st General 10 Assembly by any unit of local government, including a home rule 11 unit, that imposes a tax, fee, or other assessment other than 12 the normal sales tax rate for goods on a firearm, firearm 13 attachment, or firearm ammunition are invalid and void.

14 (d) For the purposes of this Section, "handgun" has the 15 meaning ascribed to it in Section 5 of the Firearm Concealed 16 Carry Act.

(e) This Section is a denial and limitation of home rule
powers and functions under subsection (h) of Section 6 of
Article VII of the Illinois Constitution.
