## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

10 ILCS 5/19-2	from Ch.	46,	par. 19-2
10 ILCS 5/19-3	from Ch.	46,	par. 19-3

Amends the Election Code. Allows an elector to be added to a list of permanent vote by mail status voters who receive an official vote by mail ballot for all subsequent elections. Provides that voters whose application for permanent vote by mail status is accepted by the election authority shall remain on the permanent vote by mail list until either the voter requests to be removed from permanent vote by mail status or provides notice to the election authority of a change in registration. Provides the application form for a permanent vote by mail ballot.

A BILL FOR

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AN ACT concerning elections.

#### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 2 represented in the General Assembly: 3

Section 5. The Election Code is amended by changing 4 5 Sections 19-2 and 19-3 as follows:

(10 ILCS 5/19-2) (from Ch. 46, par. 19-2) 6

7 Sec. 19-2. Any elector as defined in Section 19-1 may by mail or electronically on the website of the appropriate 8 9 election authority, not more than 90 nor less than 5 days prior to the date of such election, or by personal delivery not more 10 than 90 nor less than one day prior to the date of such 11 election, make application to the county clerk or to the Board 12 of Election Commissioners for an official ballot for the 13 14 voter's precinct to be voted at such election, or be added to a list of permanent vote by mail status voters who receive an 15 16 official vote by mail ballot for all subsequent elections. 17 Voters who make an application for permanent vote by mail ballot status shall follow the procedures specified herein. 18 19 Voters whose application for permanent vote by mail status is 20 accepted by the election authority shall remain on the 21 permanent vote by mail list until either the voter requests to 22 be removed from permanent vote by mail status or provides notice to the election authority of a change in registration. 23

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1 The URL address at which voters may electronically request a 2 vote by mail ballot shall be fixed no later than 90 calendar 3 days before an election and shall not be changed until after 4 the election. Such a ballot shall be delivered to the elector 5 only upon separate application by the elector for each 6 election.

I understand that this application is made for an official vote by mail ballot or ballots to be voted by me at the election specified in this application and that I must submit a separate application for an official vote by mail ballot or ballots to be voted by me at any subsequent election.

21 However, if application is made for a primary election 22 ballot, such application shall require the applicant to 23 designate the name of the political party with which the 24 applicant is affiliated.

25 If application is made electronically, the applicant shall 26 mark the box associated with the above described statement

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included as part of the online application certifying that the statements set forth in this application are true and correct, and a signature is not required.

Any person may produce, reproduce, distribute, or return to 4 5 an election authority the application for vote by mail ballot. If applications are sent to a post office box controlled by any 6 7 individual or organization that is not an election authority, 8 those applications shall (i) include a valid and current phone 9 number for the individual or organization controlling the post 10 office box and (ii) be turned over to the appropriate election 11 authority within 7 days of receipt or, if received within 2 12 weeks of the election in which an applicant intends to vote, within 2 days of receipt. Failure to turn over the applications 13 14 in compliance with this paragraph shall constitute a violation 15 of this Code and shall be punishable as a petty offense with a 16 fine of \$100 per application. Removing, tampering with, or 17 otherwise knowingly making the postmark on the application unreadable by the election authority shall establish a 18 rebuttable presumption of a violation of this paragraph. Upon 19 20 receipt, the appropriate election authority shall accept and promptly process any application for vote by mail ballot 21 22 submitted in a form substantially similar to that required by 23 this Section, including any substantially similar production or reproduction generated by the applicant. 24
