SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

230 ILCS 40/65

Amends the Video Gaming Act. Requires a unit of government, including a home rule unit, to impose a fee for the operation of a video gaming terminal of \$1,000 per year (rather than prohibiting a non-home rule unit of government to impose any fee for the operation of a video gaming terminal in excess of \$25 per year). Limits home rule.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Video Gaming Act is amended by changing
Section 65 as follows:

(230 ILCS 40/65) 6 7 Sec. 65. Fees. A unit of government, including a home rule unit, shall impose a fee for the operation of a video gaming 8 9 terminal of \$1,000 per year. A home rule unit may not impose a 10 fee in an amount other than that provided in this Section. This Section is a denial and limitation of home rule powers and 11 functions under subsection (h) of Section 6 of Article VII of 12 the Illinois Constitution. A non home rule unit of government 13 14 may not impose any fee for the operation of a video gaming 15 terminal in excess of \$25 per year.
