## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

815 ILCS 505/2WWW new

Amends the Consumer Fraud and Deceptive Business Practices Act. Provides that it is an unlawful practice to advertise, or make available for inclusion in Internet search results, a rate for a hotel, motel, or other place of short-term lodging that does not include all required fees, excluding taxes or other governmentally imposed fees.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Consumer Fraud and Deceptive Business
Practices Act is amended by adding Section 2WWW as follows:

6 (815 ILCS 505/2WWW new) 7 Sec. 2WWW. Unfair and deceptive advertising of room rates. (a) As used in this Section: 8 9 "Casino hotel" has the meaning ascribed to that term in the North American Industry Classification System under code 10 11 721120. "Hotel" and "motel" have the meanings ascribed to those 12 terms in the North American Industry Classification System 13 14 under code 721110. "Short-term rental" means a single-family dwelling, or a 15 residential dwelling unit in a multi-unit structure, 16 condominium, cooperative, timeshare, or similar joint property 17 ownership arrangement that is rented for a fee for less than 30 18 19 consecutive days. "Short-term rental" includes vacation 20 rentals. "Short-term rental" does not include: 21 (1) a unit that is used for any non-residential

2	(2) a bed and breakfast establishment as defined in
3	Section 2 of the Bed and Breakfast Act; or
4	(3) transient accommodations, including hotels and
5	motels that are not classified as residential property for
6	real property taxation purposes.
7	(b) No person shall advertise, or make available for
8	inclusion in Internet search results, a rate for a casino
9	hotel, hotel, motel, or other short-term lodging that does not
10	include all required fees, excluding taxes and fees imposed by
11	a government.
12	(c) A violation of this Section constitutes an unlawful
13	practice within the meaning of this Act.
