1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 185

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 185 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Public Community College Act is amended by  
5 changing Sections 3-7.24 and 3-9 and by adding Section 3-80 as  
6 follows:

7 (110 ILCS 805/3-7.24) (from Ch. 122, par. 103-7.24)

8 Sec. 3-7.24. Student board member.

9 (a) Each community college board shall have one ~~non-voting~~  
10 member who is a student enrolled in the community college under  
11 the jurisdiction of the board. One ~~non-voting~~ student member  
12 shall also be selected in multi-campus districts to represent  
13 all campuses in those districts. In multi-campus districts, the  
14 campus from which the member is selected shall be determined by  
15 lot each year, provided that no campus shall twice have  
16 selected a ~~non-voting~~ student member until all campuses in the

1 district have once been represented on the district board. The  
2 same procedure shall be followed until all campuses have been  
3 represented a second time, a third time, and subsequent times.  
4 The method of selecting these student members shall be  
5 determined by campus-wide student referendum.

6 (b) A ~~The student member members~~ shall serve a term of one  
7 year beginning on April 15 of each year, except that the  
8 student member initially selected shall serve a term beginning  
9 on the date of selection and expiring on the next succeeding  
10 June 30.

11 (c) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (d), a  
12 student member shall be a nonvoting student member. Nonvoting  
13 ~~The nonvoting~~ student members shall have all of the privileges  
14 of membership, including the right to make and second motions  
15 and to attend executive sessions, other than the right to vote.

16 (d) The student member of the Board of Trustees of  
17 Community College District No. 536 shall be a voting student  
18 member. The board of any other community college district may  
19 elect to allow a student member to be a voting student member.  
20 A voting student member shall have all of the privileges of  
21 membership, including the right to make and second motions and  
22 to attend executive sessions and the right to vote on all board  
23 matters except those involving faculty tenure, faculty  
24 promotion, or any issue on which the student member has a  
25 direct conflict of interest. For the purposes of this  
26 subsection (d), the student member shall not be deemed to have

1 a direct conflict of interest in and may vote on any item  
2 involving the employment or compensation of the president of  
3 the community college or the election of officers.

5 (110 ILCS 805/3-9) (from Ch. 122, par. 103-9)

6 Sec. 3-9. A majority of full voting membership of the Board  
7 shall constitute a quorum. However, a voting student member who  
8 is not entitled to vote on a measure at a meeting of the Board  
9 or any of its committees shall not be considered a member for  
10 the purpose of determining whether a quorum is present at the  
11 time that measure is voted upon. For all meetings of the Board,  
12 a quorum of members must be physically present at the location  
13 of the meeting. When a vote is taken upon any measure before  
14 the Board, a quorum being present, a majority of the members  
15 voting on the measure shall determine the outcome thereof. No  
16 action of such board shall be invalidated by reason of any  
17 vacancies on such board, or by reason of any failure to select  
18 any ~~nonvoting~~ student members.

21 Sec. 3-80. Termination or nonrenewal of employment  
22 contract; president. If a board decides to terminate or not  
23 renew the employment contract of the president of a community  
24 college, then, for one year after the decision was voted upon,

1 no person who was a member of the board at the time of the vote  
2 may be selected to serve as president of the community college.

3 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon  
4 becoming law.".
