#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

105 ILCS 5/2-3.176 new  
105 ILCS 5/10-20.69 new  
105 ILCS 5/34-18.61 new

Amends the School Code. Provides that, upon knowledge of an incident of sexual assault by a student against another student, a school district shall report the incident to the State Board of Education; defines "sexual assault". Provides that the State Board shall post on its website for each school year the total number of reported incidents statewide and in each school district. Provides that the State Board shall also report the data annually to the General Assembly no later than September 1 of each year.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Sections  
5 2-3.176, 10-20.69, and 34-18.61 as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 5/2-3.176 new)

7 Sec. 2-3.176. Sexual assault data. The State Board of  
8 Education shall post on its website for each school year the  
9 total number of incidents reported under Sections 10-20.69 and  
10 34-18.61 of this Code statewide and in each school district.  
11 The State Board shall also report the data annually to the  
12 General Assembly no later than September 1 of each year.

19 through 11-1.60 of the Criminal Code of 2012.
