SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

330 ILCS 140/5 330 ILCS 140/10

Amends the Veterans' and Military Discount Program Act. Provides that veterans, military personnel, and those spouses and dependents of veterans and military personnel who have been issued valid Military ID or Military Dependent ID cards (rather than only veterans and military personnel) may receive a discount on goods and services from participating merchants, or another appropriate money-saving promotion of a merchant's choice, under the Veterans' and Military Discount Program. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning veterans.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Veterans' and Military Discount Program Act
is amended by changing Sections 5 and 10 as follows:

6 (330 ILCS 140/5)

7 Sec. 5. Legislative findings. The General Assembly finds 8 that though there is no way to adequately repay our nation's 9 military personnel for their service and sacrifice, we can demonstrate our gratitude by forging a collaborative effort 10 between businesses and government that will connect veterans 11 and active duty service members with merchants who choose to 12 honor their military service through special discounts and 13 14 promotions.

The Veterans' and Military Discount Program, created under 15 16 this Act, will enable veterans (those honorably discharged and other veterans generally discharged for reasons other than 17 discipline, misconduct, resignation in lieu of misconduct 18 19 charges, unfitness for duty, voluntary resignation, or court martial), and military personnel currently serving our 20 21 country, and those spouses and dependents of veterans and 22 military personnel who have been issued a valid Military ID card or Military Dependent ID card to receive a discount on 23

1 goods and services from participating merchants, or another 2 appropriate money-saving promotion of a merchant's choice.

3 The Veterans' and Military Discount Program will be 4 mutually beneficial, helping active duty service members and 5 veterans in the State save money with discounts on goods and 6 services, and helping business owners to enjoy increased 7 traffic and sales in their stores.

10 Sec. 10. Veterans' and Military Discount Program. The 11 Department of Veterans' Affairs shall establish and administer 12 a Veterans' and Military Discount Program that enables 13 veterans, and active duty military personnel, and those spouses 14 and dependents of veterans and military personnel who have been issued a valid Military ID card or Military Dependent ID card 15 16 to use the following photo identification at participating merchants to receive a discount on goods and services or to 17 18 receive another appropriate money-saving promotion of a merchant's choice: 19

(1) veterans who have a valid driver's license or 20 21 Illinois Identification Card issued pursuant to subsection 22 (e) of Section 6-106 of the Illinois Vehicle Code or (c-5) of Section 23 subsection 4 of the Illinois 24 Identification Card Act; and

(2) active duty military personnel who have a valid
