Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. In addition to other amounts appropriated, the 6 amount of \$2,025,500, or so much thereof as may be necessary, 7 is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois 8 Emergency Management Agency for operational expenses, awards, 9 grants, administrative expenses, including refunds, and 10 permanent improvements.
