Introduced 2/5/2020, by Sen. Mattie Hunter

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

820 ILCS 90/5 820 ILCS 90/10

Amends the Illinois Freedom to Work Act. Expands the scope of the Act to apply to all employees (rather than only low-wage employees). Prohibits all covenants not to compete. Effective immediately.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Freedom to Work Act is amended by 5 changing Sections 5 and 10 as follows:

6 (820 ILCS 90/5)

7 Sec. 5. Definitions. In this Act:

8 "Covenant not to compete" means an agreement:

9 (1) between an employer and <u>an</u> <del>a low-wage</del> employee that 10 restricts <u>the</u> <del>such low-wage</del> employee from performing:</del>

11 (A) any work for another employer for a specified
12 period of time;

13	(B) any work in a specified geographical area; or
14	(C) work for another employer that is similar to
15	the such low wage employee's work for the employer
16	included as a party to the agreement; and

17 (2) that is entered into after the effective date of
18 this <u>amendatory</u> Act <u>of the 101st General Assembly</u>.

"Employer" has the meaning given to such term in subsection (c) of Section 3 of the Minimum Wage Law. "Employer" does not include governmental or quasi-governmental bodies.

22 <u>"Employee"</u> "Low-wage employee" means <u>any individual</u>
23 permitted to work by an employer an employee whose earnings do

1 not exceed the greater of (1) the hourly rate equal to the 2 minimum wage required by the applicable federal, State, or 3 local minimum wage law or (2) \$13.00 per hour.

6 Sec. 10. Prohibiting covenants not to compete for low-wage 7 employees.

8 (a) <u>After the effective date of this amendatory Act of the</u> 9 <u>101st General Assembly, no</u> <del>No</del> employer shall enter into a 10 covenant not to compete with any <del>low-wage</del> employee of the 11 employer.

(b) A covenant not to compete entered into between an
employer and <u>an a low-wage</u> employee is illegal and void.
