SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT SC0005

Introduced 2/13/2019, by Sen. Paul Schimpf

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

ILCON Art. VIII, Sec. 2

Proposes to amend the Finance Article of the Illinois Constitution. Provides that if the General Assembly fails to pass a State budget setting forth appropriations for the ensuing fiscal year on or before May 31 of the year in which such budget is submitted, such existing appropriations provided for the previous fiscal year shall be in effect in the new fiscal year and all subsequent fiscal years until amended or eliminated by the General Assembly. Effective upon being declared adopted.

2 CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED FIRST GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING HEREIN, that there shall be submitted to the electors of the State for adoption or rejection at the general election next occurring at least 6 months after the adoption of this resolution a proposition to Section 2 of Article VIII of the Illinois Constitution as follows:

10 ARTICLE VIII

- 13 SECTION 2. STATE FINANCE
- 14 (a) The Governor shall prepare and submit to the General Assembly, at a time prescribed by law, a State budget for the 15 ensuing fiscal year. The budget shall set forth the estimated 16 17 balance of funds available for appropriation at the beginning 18 of the fiscal year, the estimated receipts, and a plan for 19 expenditures and obligations during the fiscal year of every 20 department, authority, public corporation and quasi-public corporation of the State, every State college and university, 21 22 and every other public agency created by the State, but not of 23 units of local government or school districts. The budget shall

- 1 also set forth the indebtedness and contingent liabilities of
- 2 the State and such other information as may be required by law.
- Proposed expenditures shall not exceed funds estimated to be 3
- available for the fiscal year as shown in the budget. 4
