1 SENATE RESOLUTION WHEREAS, The State of Illinois exempts State taxation of 2 3 retirement income; and WHEREAS, Retirees living on a fixed income have limited 4 ability to rejoin the workforce, face high health care costs, 5 6 and have little ability to save money; and 7 WHEREAS, Retirees could not have anticipated in their 8 lifetime of planning that their retirement income would 9 suddenly be taxed by the State, forcing them to cut already strained household budgets; and 10 11 WHEREAS, Retirees do pay many other taxes, such as federal 12 income taxes, property taxes, and sales taxes; and 13 WHEREAS, The exclusion of taxing retirement 14 encourages residents to remain living in Illinois throughout 15 their retirement and encourages newly retired Americans to 16 relocate to the State; therefore, be it 17 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED FIRST GENERAL 18 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we state our belief 19 that the Illinois Income Tax Act should not be amended to 20 permit taxing retirement income; and be it further

RESOLVED, That suitable copies of this resolution be delivered to all Illinois constitutional officers, the Speaker and Minority Leader of the Illinois House of Representatives, and the President and Minority Leader of the Illinois Senate.
