2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois Senate are saddened to 3 learn of the death of Roy E. Bayless of Silvis, who passed away 4 on March 24, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Roy Bayless was born in Huntington, West Virginia to James L. and Mary (Barrett) Bayless on February 7, 1925; he graduated from high school in 1943; he served in the U.S. Navy in the Pacific; he was discharged from the Navy in April 1946; he married his high school sweetheart Betty Lou Preston in Bowling Green, Ohio on April 28, 1946; and

WHEREAS, Roy Bayless was hired by the Airlines National Terminal Service Company and the Airport Operations Company, where he spent 13 years in various airport operation positions; he left Willow Run, Michigan as Assistant Airport Manager for the Airport Director position in Riverside, California in 1959; while there, he was named Airport Manager of the Year; he accepted the position of Director of Aviation in Austin, Texas in 1974; and

WHEREAS, Roy Bayless served in a number of organizations during his career; in Riverside, he was elected president of the California Association of Airport Executives and served as chairman of the Airport Administrators Council for three years;

- 9 grandsons, at the family's home on Lake Wisconsin; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Roy Bayless is survived by his wife of 73 years,

- 12 Bayless; his grandchildren, Marcus (Julie) Quaranta, Chad
- 13 (Julie) Quaranta, and Kelli Schafer; and his six
