SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Removes the cost-of-living increase given to the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of State, Attorney General, Comptroller, State Treasurer, and members of the General Assembly for Fiscal Year 2024. Effective immediately.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. "AN ACT concerning appropriations", Public Act
5 103-6, approved with items reduced on June 7, 2023, is amended
6 by changing Sections 35 and 45 of Article 33 as follows:

7 Section 35. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
8 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the
9 State Comptroller to pay the elected State officers of the
10 Executive Branch of the State Government, at various rates
11 prescribed by law:

12	For the Governor	<u>205,700</u>	216,000
13	For the Lieutenant Governor	<u>160,900</u>	169,000
14	For the Secretary of State	<u>183,300</u>	192,500
15	For the Attorney General	<u>183,300</u>	192,500
16	For the Comptroller	<u>160,900</u>	169,000
17	For the State Treasurer	<u>160,900</u>	169,000
18	Total	<u>\$1,055,000</u>	\$1,108,000

19 Section 45. The following named sums, or so much thereof
20 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the
21 State Comptroller to pay certain officers of the Legislative

1 Branch of the State Government, at the various rates prescribed
2 by law:

3 Office of Auditor General

4 For the Auditor General193,200

5 For two Deputy Auditor Generals278,100

6 Total \$471,300

7 For salaries of the members of the General Assembly, for both
8 the House of Representatives and the Senate; including base
9 salary of \$85,000 ~~\$89,675~~ for each member of the General
10 Assembly and additional amounts, as prescribed by law, for
11 Speaker of the House, President of the Senate, Minority Leader
12 of the House, Minority Leader of the Senate, Speaker Pro Tempore
13 of the House, President Pro Tempore of the Senate, Majority
14 Leaders in both chambers, 10 assistant majority and minority
15 leaders in the Senate, 12 assistant majority and minority
16 leaders, majority and minority caucus chairmen in the Senate,
17 majority and minority conference chairmen in the House, 2
18 Deputy Majority and the 2 Deputy Minority leaders in the House,
19 Majority Officer in the House, Majority Officer in the Senate,
20 chairmen and minority spokesmen of standing committees in the
21 Senate (except the Committee on Assignments), and chairmen and
