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1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 647 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend Senate Bill 647 on page 7, 2 line 23, by inserting "within 12 months" after "occurring"; 3 4 and on page 8, line 15, by deleting "and the Medical Licensing 5 6 Board"; and 7 on page 9, by replacing lines 2 through 13 with the following: "(2) Upon the Department of Human Services providing 8 written information to birthing hospitals, all birthing 9 hospitals shall provide new mothers, prior to discharge 10 following childbirth, and, if possible, shall provide 11 12 fathers and other family members with complete information about maternal mental health conditions, including their 13 14 symptoms, methods of coping with the illness, treatment 15 resources, post-hospital treatment options, and community 16 resources. Hospitals shall supplement the resources

- 1 provided by the Department to include relevant resources
- offered by the hospital, in the region, or community in 2
- which the birthing hospital is located, if available. 3
- 4 Resources may be provided in an electronic format such as
- 5 website links or QR Codes."; and
- on page 11, line 1, by deleting "and the Medical Licensing 6
- 7 Board"; and
- 8 on page 11, line 3, by inserting after the period the
- 9 following:
- "Health care professionals or organizations representing 10
- health care professionals with expertise in the treatment of 11
- 12 maternal mental health conditions shall be consulted in the
- 13 development of the educational materials."; and
- on page 11, line 4, by replacing "2021" with "2026 2021". 14
