

103RD GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2023 and 2024 SB3221

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

705 ILCS 35/2f-14

Amends the Circuit Courts Act. Deletes language providing that certain at-large judgeships of the 6th judicial circuit shall be converted, as they become vacant, to resident judgeships elected from Champaign County and resident judgeships elected from Macon County.

1 AN ACT concerning courts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Circuit Courts Act is amended by changing

 Section 2f-14 as follows:

- 7 Sec. 2f-14. 6th judicial circuit; resident judgeships.
- (a) The at-large judgeships of the 6th judicial circuit 8 9 existing on January 7, 2022 shall be converted to resident judgeships as provided in this subsection as those judgeships 10 are or become vacant. The first 3 that become vacant after 11 January 7, 2022 (the effective date of Public Act 102-693) 12 13 shall be converted to resident judgeships elected from 14 Champaign County. The remaining two at large judgeships that 15 become vacant shall be converted to resident judgeships 16 elected from Macon County. Thereafter, persons elected to those resident judgeships shall be residents of the county 17 which elects them. 18
 - (b) It is the intent of the General Assembly not to create any additional judgeships in the 6th judicial circuit by Public Act 102-693 and this amendatory Act of the 102nd General Assembly. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the conversion of at-large judgeships to

- 1 resident judgeships under subsection (a) of this Section shall
- 2 not entitle the 6th judicial circuit to any additional circuit
- judgeships elected at-large.
