1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

11 Section 40. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much of that
 12 amount as may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close
 13 of business on June 30, 2024, from an appropriation heretofore
 14 made for such purposes in Article 40, Section 40 of Public Act
 15 103-0006, as amended is reappropriated from the General Revenue
 16 Fund to the Department on Aging for a grant to the Age Options
 17 in Oak Park for operating expenses.

18 Section 45. The sum of \$150,000, or so much of that amount
 19 as may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of
 20 business on June 30, 2024, from an appropriation heretofore
 21 made for such purposes in Article 40, Section 45 of Public Act
 22 103-0006, as amended is reappropriated from the General Revenue

1 Fund to the Department on Aging for a grant to the Senior
2 Services Center of Will County for costs associated with the
3 Grandparents Raising Grandchildren Pilot Program.

4 Section 50. The sum of \$600,000, or so much thereof as may
5 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to
6 the Department on Aging for costs associated with Multisector
7 Planning, including but not limited to ordinary and contingent
8 expenses.

9 Section 55. The amount of \$125,000, or so much thereof as
10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Department on Aging
11 Federal Indirect Cost Fund to the Department on Aging for all
12 costs associated with administration and programmatic grant
13 activities.

14 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
15 2024.
