5 WHEREAS, Clyde McKenrick was born to Homer and Mary 6 McKenrick on February 13, 1929 and was raised on the family 7 farm near Low Moor, Iowa; he attended Low Moor and Malone 8 Elementary Schools, Elvira High School, and Coe College; he 9 married Frances Lois McKenrick at Low Moor Methodist Church in 10 Low Moor, Iowa on December 23, 1949; he served in the U.S. Army 11 in Korea and at Wolters Air Force Base in Texas with the 12 Special Category Army with Air Force from 1952 and 1953; and

13 WHEREAS, Clyde McKenrick worked at Curtis Brothers 14 Woodwork from 1948 to 1952 and from 1953 to 1966, Standard 15 Brands, also known as Clinton Corn Processing Co., from 1966 16 to 1982, and Indiana Sugars from 1982 to 1991; and

17 WHEREAS, Clyde McKenrick was a member of Riverside United 18 Methodist Church, Camanche Masonic Lodge #60 A.F.A.M., where 19 was a past master and 50-year member, Clinton Scottish Rite 20 Bodies, Low Moor O.E.S., where he was a past patron, and the 21 Korean War Veterans Association, where he served as the 22 Illinois state secretary in 2014; and 1 WHEREAS, Clyde McKenrick was preceded in death by his 2 parents; two children; a great-granddaughter; a brother; and a 3 niece; and
