## SENATE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, Parks and recreation programs are an integral 3 part of communities throughout this country, including the 4 State of Illinois; and

5 WHEREAS, Parks and recreation are vitally important to 6 establishing and maintaining the quality of life in 7 communities, ensuring the health of all citizens, and 8 contributing to the economic and environmental well-being of a 9 community and region; and

10 WHEREAS, Parks and recreation programs build healthy, 11 active communities that aid in the prevention of chronic 12 disease, provide therapeutic recreation services for those who 13 are mentally or physically disabled, and also improve the 14 mental and emotional health of all citizens; and

15 WHEREAS, Parks and recreation programs increase a 16 community's economic prosperity through increased property 17 values, expansion of the local tax base, increased tourism, 18 the attraction and retention of businesses, and crime 19 reduction; and

20 WHEREAS, Park districts, forest preserves, and 21 conservation, recreation, and special recreation agencies are SR0957 -2- LRB103 40455 MST 72814 r significant statewide employers of youth, with more than half of their nearly 57,000 employees being under the age of 25; and

3 WHEREAS, Parks and recreation areas are fundamental to the 4 environmental well-being of our communities; and

5 WHEREAS, Parks and natural recreation areas improve water 6 quality, protect groundwater, prevent flooding, improve the 7 quality of the air we breathe, provide vegetative buffers to 8 development, and produce habitat for wildlife; and

9 WHEREAS, Our parks and natural recreation areas ensure the 10 ecological beauty of our communities and provide a place for 11 children and adults to connect with nature and recreate 12 outdoors; therefore, be it

13 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED THIRD GENERAL 14 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we declare July 2024 as 15 Parks and Recreation Month; and be it further

16 RESOLVED, That suitable copies of this resolution be 17 delivered to the Illinois Association of Park Districts, the 18 Illinois Park and Recreation Association, the National 19 Recreation and Park Association, and the Illinois Department 20 of National Resources.
