HOUSE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois House of Representatives wish to recognize MacCormac College for 100 years of continuous and vital post-secondary education in the City of Chicago; and

WHEREAS, Nearly a century ago MacCormac opened its doors to students seeking a business education in Chicago; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Morton MacCormac, a descendant of John Morton, a signer of the Declaration of Independence, and his wife Mary, founded MacCormac College; its first location was the Woodlawn National Bank Building near the University of Chicago; in the following decades, MacCormac moved to several Chicago locations including LaSalle Street near the Chicago Board of Trade and the South Loop area known as the "Education District"; in May 2001, the Chicago campus was relocated to newly renovated space in the Heyworth Building at 29 E. Madison; this new location is just steps away from the crossroads of Chicago at State and Madison; and

WHEREAS, While MacCormac has been known primarily as a business college for decades, the school has also revolutionized instruction in Law programs such as Court Reporting and Paralegal Studies; MacCormac has always been known for its ability to adapt to changing times, and in recent years has added such programs as International Business and Medical Transcription to its curricular offerings; and

WHEREAS, As MacCormac enters the twenty-first century, it takes pride in leading the way with technological advances in instruction that prepare its students for an increasingly complex and exciting world; at the same time, MacCormac College never forgets its proud tradition of personalized instruction in a highly professional atmosphere; therefore, be it
