

1 AN ACT making appropriations.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,  
3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 1. The following named amounts, or so much  
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects  
7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the  
8 General Revenue Fund for the ordinary and contingent expenses  
9 of the Office of Management and Budget in the Executive  
10 Office of the Governor:

27 Section 2. The amount of \$1,384,600, or so much thereof  
28 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Capital  
29 Development Fund to the Office of Management and Budget for  
30 ordinary and contingent expenses associated with the sale and

1 administration of General Obligation bonds.

2 Section 3. The amount of \$425,000, or so much thereof as  
3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Build Illinois  
4 Bond Fund to the Office of Management and Budget for ordinary  
5 and contingent expenses associated with the sale and  
6 administration of Build Illinois bonds.

7 Section 4. The amount of \$260,000,000, or so much  
8 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Build  
9 Illinois Bond Retirement and Interest Fund to the Office of  
10 Management and Budget for the purpose of making payments to  
11 the Trustee under the Master Indenture as defined by and  
12 pursuant to the Build Illinois Bond Act.

13 Section 5. The amount of \$113,400, or so much thereof as  
14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the School  
15 Infrastructure Fund to the Office of Management and Budget  
16 for operational expenses related to the School Infrastructure  
17 Program.

18 Section 6. No contract shall be entered into or  
19 obligation incurred for any expenditures from the  
20 appropriations made in Sections 2, 3, and 4 until after the  
21 purposes and amounts have been approved in writing by the  
22 Governor.

23 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect on  
24 July 1, 2003.
