Amends the Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning a defendant's waiver of his or her right to be present during trial.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning criminal law.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963 is  
5 amended by changing Section 115-8 as follows:

6 (725 ILCS 5/115-8) (from Ch. 38, par. 115-8)  
7 Sec. 115-8.

8 A defendant may waive his right to be present during trial.  
9 However, upon motion of the ~~the~~ State's Attorney made prior to  
10 or during trial, the court shall order the defendant to present  
11 himself in open court for the purpose of identification.
