Appropriates \$2,000,000 to the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity from the General Revenue Fund for a grant to the Black Chamber of Commerce of Lake County for the creation of the Black Chamber of Commerce Training Academy (BCCTA) and the creation of the pre-apprenticeship construction skills training program. Effective July 1, 2011.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The sum of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof as
5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
6 Fund to the Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity
7 for a grant to the Black Chamber of Commerce of Lake County
8 for the creation of the Black Chamber of Commerce Training
9 Academy (BCCTA) and the creation of the pre-apprenticeship
10 construction skills training program.

11 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
12 2011.
