- "(7) Additional preferences. Up to 5 additional preference points may be awarded for unique categories based on an applicant's experience or background as identified by the commission.
- (8) Scoring of preferences. The commission shall give 6 preference for original appointment to persons designated in 7 item (1) by adding to the final grade that they receive 5 8 9 points for the recognized preference achieved. The commission 10 shall determine the number of preference points for each category except (1). The number of preference points for each 11 category shall range from 0 to 5. In determining the number of 12 preference points, the commission shall prescribe that if a 13 14 candidate earns the maximum number of preference points in all 15 categories, that number may not be less than 10 nor more than 30. The commission shall give preference for original 16 appointment to persons designated in items (2) through (7) by 17 adding the requisite number of points to the final grade for 18 19 each recognized preference achieved. The numerical result 20 thus".
