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A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Whenever it becomes necessary for the State or any
 6 governmental unit to furnish in a disaster area emergency
 7 services directly related to or required by a disaster and
 8 existing funds are insufficient to provide such services, the
 9 Governor may, when he considers such action in the best
 10 interest of the State, release funds from the General Revenue
 11 disaster relief appropriation in order to provide such
 12 services or to reimburse local governmental bodies furnishing
 13 such services. Such appropriation may be used for payment of
 14 the Illinois National Guard when called to active duty in
 15 case of disaster, and for the emergency purchase or renting
 16 of equipment and commodities. Such appropriation shall be
 17 used for emergency services and relief to the disaster area
 18 as a whole and shall not be used to provide private relief to
 19 persons sustaining property damages or personal injury as a
 20 result of a disaster.

1 Section 10. The sum of \$1,125,000, or so much thereof as
 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Nuclear Safety

1 Facility Development and Operation Fund:
 2 For Refunds for Overpayments made by Low-
 3 Level Waste Generators4,900

4 Section 45. The sum of \$1,350,500, or so much thereof as
 5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation
 6 Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency
 7 for licensing facilities where radioactive uranium and
 8 thorium mill tailings are generated or located, and related
 9 costs for regulating the decontamination and decommissioning
 10 of such facilities and for identification, decontamination
 11 and environmental monitoring of unlicensed properties
 12 contaminated with such radioactive mill tailings.

13 Section 50. The sum of \$320,000, or so much thereof as
 14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation
 15 Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency
 16 for the purpose of funding costs related to environmental
 17 cleanup of the Ottawa Radiation Areas Superfund Project under
 18 cooperative agreements with the Federal Government.

19 Section 55. The sum of \$145,500, or so much thereof as
 20 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation
 21 Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency
 22 for recovery and remediation of radioactive materials and

1 contaminated facilities or properties when such expenses
2 cannot be paid by a responsible person or an available
3 surety.

4 Section 60. The sum of \$373,500, or so much thereof as
5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation
6 Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency
7 for local responder training, demonstrations, research,
8 studies and investigations under funding agreements with the
9 Federal Government.

10 Section 65. The sum of \$97,000, or so much thereof as
11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Nuclear Safety
12 Emergency Preparedness Fund to the Illinois Emergency
13 Management Agency for related training and travel expenses
14 and to reimburse the Illinois State Police and the Illinois
15 Commerce Commission for costs incurred for activities related
16 to inspecting and escorting shipments of spent nuclear fuel,
17 high-level radioactive waste, and transuranic waste in
18 Illinois as provided under the rules of the Agency.

19 Section 70. The sum of \$215,000, or so much thereof as
20 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Sheffield Agreed
21 Order Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for
22 the care, maintenance, monitoring, testing, remediation and

1 insurance of the low-level radioactive waste disposal site
2 near Sheffield, Illinois.

3 Section 75. The sum of \$585,000, or so much thereof as
4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Low-Level
5 Radioactive Waste Facility Development and Operation Fund to
6 the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for use in
7 accordance with Section 14(a) of the Illinois Low-Level
8 Radioactive Waste Management Act for costs related to
9 establishing a low-level radioactive waste disposal facility.

10 Section 85. The sum of \$210,000, or so much thereof as
11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation
12 Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency
13 for costs and expenses related to or in support of a public
14 safety shared services center.

15 Section 85. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as
16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Civil
17 Preparedness Administrative Fund to the Illinois Emergency
18 Management Agency for costs and expenses related to or in
19 support of a public safety shared services center.

20 Section 90. The sum of \$686,000, or so much thereof as
21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Nuclear Safety

1 Emergency Preparedness Fund to the Illinois Emergency
2 Management Agency for costs and expenses related to or in
3 support of a public safety shared services center.

4 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
5 2011.
