1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 1581

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 1581 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding  
5 Section 11-1432 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/11-1432 new)

7 Sec. 11-1432. Animals in driver's lap.

8 (a) A driver may not hold an animal in his or her lap while  
9 operating a motor vehicle. This Section shall not apply to the  
10 following motor vehicles as defined by this Code:

11 (1) commercial motor vehicles;

12 (2) farm tractors;

13 (3) implements of husbandry; and

14 (4) farm to market agricultural transportation.

15 (b) A person who violates this Section is guilty of a petty  
16 offense and subject to a fine not to exceed \$25.

1       (c) A law enforcement officer may not stop or search a  
2 motor vehicle, its contents, the driver, or a passenger solely  
3 because of a violation or suspected violation of this Section.

4       Section 10. The Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963 is  
5 amended by changing Section 108-1 as follows:

6       (725 ILCS 5/108-1) (from Ch. 38, par. 108-1)

7       Sec. 108-1. Search without warrant.

8       (1) When a lawful arrest is effected a peace officer may  
9 reasonably search the person arrested and the area within such  
10 person's immediate presence for the purpose of:

11           (a) protecting the officer from attack; or

12           (b) preventing the person from escaping; or

13           (c) discovering the fruits of the crime; or

14           (d) discovering any instruments, articles, or things  
15 which may have been used in the commission of, or which may  
16 constitute evidence of, an offense.

17       (2) (Blank).

18       (3) A law enforcement officer may not search or inspect a  
19 motor vehicle, its contents, the driver, or a passenger solely  
20 because of a violation of Section 12-603.1 of the Illinois  
21 Vehicle Code.

22       (4) A law enforcement officer may not stop or search a  
23 motor vehicle, its contents, the driver, or a passenger solely  
24 because of a violation or suspected violation of Section

1 11-1432 of the Illinois Vehicle Code.
