Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides for issuance of U.S. Air Force license plates, with eligibility requirements to be determined by the Secretary of State. Effective immediately.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding
 Section 3-699.14 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/3-699.14 new)

7 <u>Sec. 3-699.14. U.S. Air Force license plates.</u>

(a) In addition to any other special license plate, the 8 9 Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and applications 10 made in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State, may issue U.S. Air Force license plates to residents of Illinois 11 12 who meet eligibility requirements prescribed by the Secretary of State. The special U.S. Air Force plate issued under this 13 14 Section shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division, motorcycles, and motor vehicles of the second 15 division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates issued 16 17 under this Section shall expire according to the staggered 18 multi-year procedure established by Section 3-414.1 of this 19 Code.

20 (b) The plates shall display the U.S. Air Force emblem. In 21 all other respects, the design, color, and format of the plates 22 shall be within the discretion of the Secretary of State. The 23 Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow the plates to be
