SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

55 ILCS 5/5-1067	from Ch. 34, par. 5-1067
65 ILCS 5/11-80-18	from Ch. 24, par. 11-80-18
65 ILCS 5/11-80-19	from Ch. 24, par. 11-80-19

Amends the Counties Code. Provides that a county board shall name (currently, may name) any street, lane, road or highway, and shall regulate (currently, may regulate) the numbering of buildings and lots adjacent to any street, lane, road or highway. Provides that no change in name or numbering shall be effective until 30 days after the following entities having jurisdiction over the area are notified: (1) election authorities; (2) post office branch; and (3) 9-1-1 system. Requires the change in name or numbering to be effective no less than 30 days prior to any election. Makes conforming changes in the Illinois Municipal Code.

1 AN ACT concerning local government.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Counties Code is amended by changing Section
5 5-1067 as follows:

6 (55 ILCS 5/5-1067) (from Ch. 34, par. 5-1067)

7 Sec. 5-1067. Names of streets and highways; numbers of
8 buildings and lots. A county board shall ~~may~~ name or may change
9 the name of any street, lane, road or highway and shall ~~may~~
10 regulate the numbering of buildings and lots adjacent to any
11 street, lane, road or highway in the unincorporated area of the
12 county.

13 In counties under 1,000,000 population, a county board may
14 name or change the name of any road in the county highway
15 system or any trail under its jurisdiction.

16 No change in the name of any street, lane, road, or
17 highway, or change in the numbering of any building or lot
18 shall be effective until 30 days after the election authorities
19 having jurisdiction and the post office branch serving that
20 area and the 9-1-1 system serving that area have been notified
21 by the county board initiating such action of the change in
22 writing by certified or registered mail, or electronic means.
23 Any change in the name of any street, lane, road, or highway,

1 or change in numbering of any building or lot shall be
2 effective no less than 30 days prior to any primary or general
3 election.

5 Section 10. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by
6 changing Sections 11-80-18 and 11-80-19 as follows:

7 (65 ILCS 5/11-80-18) (from Ch. 24, par. 11-80-18)

8 Sec. 11-80-18. The corporate authorities of each
9 municipality shall ~~may~~ regulate the numbering of buildings and
10 lots. No change in the numbering of buildings and lots shall be
11 effective until 30 days after the election authorities having
12 jurisdiction in the area in which such numbering is changed and
13 the post office branch serving that area and the 9-1-1 system
14 serving that area have been notified by the corporate authority
15 initiating such action of the change in writing by certified or
16 registered mail, or electronic means. Any change in the
17 numbering of buildings and lots shall be effective no less than
18 30 days prior to any primary or general election.

21 Sec. 11-80-19. The corporate authorities of each
22 municipality shall ~~may~~ name originally and then may change the
23 name of any street, avenue, alley, or other public place. No

1 change in the name of any street, avenue, alley or other public
2 place shall be effective until 30 days after the election
3 authorities having jurisdiction in the area in which the name
4 of the public place is changed and the post office branch
5 serving that area and the 9-1-1 system serving that area have
6 been notified by the corporate authority initiating such action
7 of the change in writing by certified or registered mail, or
8 electronic means. Any change in the name of any street, avenue,
9 alley, or other public place shall be effective no less than 30
10 days prior to any primary or general election.
