#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

25 ILCS 115/1.10 new  
25 ILCS 115/1.11 new  
25 ILCS 115/1.12 new

Amends the General Assembly Compensation Act. Requires every member of the 99th General Assembly to forfeit one day of compensation per month beginning with the second 6 months of Fiscal Year 2015 through the first 6 months of Fiscal Year 2017. Effective immediately.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning State government.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The General Assembly Compensation Act is amended  
5 by adding Section 1.10, 1.11, and 1.12 as follows:

6 (25 ILCS 115/1.10 new)

7 Sec. 1.10. FY15 furlough days. During the second 6 months  
8 of the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2014, every member of the  
9 99th General Assembly is mandatorily required to forfeit one  
10 day of compensation per month. The State Comptroller shall  
11 deduct the equivalent of 1/261st of the annual salary of each  
12 member of the 99th General Assembly from the compensation of  
13 that member in each of the second 6 months of the fiscal year.  
14 For purposes of this Section, annual compensation includes  
15 compensation paid to each member by the State for one year of  
16 service pursuant to Section 1, except any payments made for  
17 mileage and allowances for travel and meals. The forfeiture  
18 required by this Section is not considered a change in salary  
19 and shall not impact pension or other benefits provided to  
20 members of the General Assembly.

21 (25 ILCS 115/1.11 new)

22 Sec. 1.11. FY16 furlough days. During each month of the

1 fiscal year beginning July 1, 2015, every member of the 99th  
2 General Assembly is mandatorily required to forfeit one day of  
3 compensation. The State Comptroller shall deduct the  
4 equivalent of 1/261st of the annual salary of each member of  
5 the 99th General Assembly from the compensation of that member  
6 in each month of the fiscal year. For purposes of this Section,  
7 annual compensation includes compensation paid to each member  
8 by the State for one year of service pursuant to Section 1,  
9 except any payments made for mileage and allowances for travel  
10 and meals. The forfeiture required by this Section is not  
11 considered a change in salary and shall not impact pension or  
12 other benefits provided to members of the General Assembly.

13 (25 ILCS 115/1.12 new)

14 Sec. 1.12. FY17 furlough days. During the first 6 months of  
15 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2016, every member of the  
16 99th General Assembly is mandatorily required to forfeit one  
17 day of compensation per month. The State Comptroller shall  
18 deduct the equivalent of 1/261st of the annual salary of each  
19 member of the 99th General Assembly from the compensation of  
20 that member in each of the first 6 months of the fiscal year.  
21 For purposes of this Section, annual compensation includes  
22 compensation paid to each member by the State for one year of  
23 service pursuant to Section 1, except any payments made for  
24 mileage and allowances for travel and meals. The forfeiture  
25 required by this Section is not considered a change in salary

1 and shall not impact pension or other benefits provided to  
2 members of the General Assembly.

3 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon  
4 becoming law.
