9 WHEREAS, The Envirothon is a hands-on environmental 10 problem-solving competition for high school-aged students in 11 the United States and Canada; and

WHEREAS, The Envirothon works in partnership with local conservation districts, forestry associations, educators, and cooperating natural resource agencies to organize and conduct competitions on the local, regional, state, and/or provincial level; and

17 WHEREAS, Illinois is an active participant in the 18 International Envirothon Competition; and

19 WHEREAS, Envirothon participants gain valuable knowledge 20 and training in ecology and natural resource management

- of soils, wildlife, aquatic ecosystems, forestry, and current
- 3 important environmental issues; and
- 4 WHEREAS, The Illinois Envirothon has been responsible for
- 5 more than 18,000 participating high school students being
- 6 taught these important natural resource principles and issues
- 7 since 1995; and
- 8 WHEREAS, It is important that the citizens of Illinois
- 9 recognize the contributions of this event toward training our
- 10 youth to be responsible caretakers of the State's precious
- 11 natural resources; therefore, be it
- 12 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
- 13 NINETY-EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that
- 14 we designate May 1, 2014 as Envirothon Day throughout Illinois
- 15 to bring recognition to the activities of the Envirothon
- 16 program.
