12 W. Peters Business College; she married Freddie Savage, Jr. on

15 business at "Live Chicken Market", where she worked as a
16 cashier; she has worked at the "Trailer" as a cook and was a
17 receptionist for Dr. Payton; eventually, she gained employment
18 at the State Building as a clerk typist, later moving up to
19 become a supervisor; in October of 1970, Yvonne and her husband
20 founded the Chesterfield Day Care Center, where she was owner
