5 Section 5. The Department of Commerce and Community 6 Affairs Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois is 7 amended by changing Section 605-115 as follows:

9 Sec. 605-115. Transfer from State Housing Board and 10 Department of Business and Economic Development. In addition 11 to the duties and <u>the</u> powers imposed elsewhere in the Civil 12 Administrative Code of Illinois, the Department has the 13 following powers:

14 (1) To exercise the rights, powers, and duties
15 vested by law in the State Housing Board under the
16 Housing Authorities Act.

17 (2) To exercise the rights, powers, and duties
18 vested by law in the State Housing Board under the
19 Housing Cooperation Law.

20 (3) To exercise the rights, powers, and duties
21 vested by law in the State Housing Board under the
22 Housing Development and Construction Act.

(4) To exercise the rights, powers, and duties
vested by law in the State Housing Board under the
Blighted Areas Redevelopment Act of 1947.

26 (5) To exercise the rights, powers, and duties
27 vested by law in the State Housing Board under the
28 Blighted Vacant Areas Development Act of 1949.

29 (6) To exercise the rights, powers, and duties
30 vested by law in the State Housing Board under the Urban
31 Community Conservation Act.

(7) To exercise the rights, powers, and duties
 vested by law in the State Housing Board under the Urban
 Renewal Consolidation Act of 1961.

4 (8) To exercise the rights, powers, and duties
5 vested by law in the State Housing Board under the
6 Redevelopment Project Rehousing Act.

7 (9) To exercise the rights, powers, and duties
8 vested by law in the State Housing Board under the State
9 Housing Act.

10 (10) To exercise the rights, powers, and duties
11 vested by law in the State Housing Board under the
12 Illinois Housing Development Act.

(11) To exercise the rights, powers, and duties
which had been vested by law in the Department of
Business and Economic Development under Sections 46.7
(renumbered; now Section 605-200 of this Law; 20 ILCS
605/605-200), 46.8 (repealed), 46.23 (repealed), and 47.1
(repealed) of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois,
previous to August 29, 1969.

20 (12) To exercise the rights, powers, and duties
21 which have been vested by law in the State Housing Board
22 under Section 6b-3 of the State Finance Act.

The Department shall render assistance and advice to and take action affecting local governments only upon request of a local government, except as otherwise provided by the powers and duties transferred to the Department by this Section.
