

AN ACT in relation to criminal law; which may be referred to as the Robb Family Act.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by adding Section 12-5.15 as follows:

(720 ILCS 5/12-5.15 new)

Sec. 12-5.15. Aggravated criminal housing management.

(a) A person commits the offense of aggravated criminal housing management when he or she commits the offense of criminal housing management; and:

(1) the condition endangering the health or safety of a person is determined to be a contributing factor in the death of that person; and

(2) the person also conceals or attempts to conceal the condition that endangered the health or safety of the person that is found to be a contributing factor in that death.

(b) Sentence. Aggravated criminal housing management is a Class 4 felony.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.
