AN ACT concerning education.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing Section 3A-16 as follows:

(105 ILCS 5/3A-16)

Sec. 3A-16. Regional office of education advisory board.

(a) Beginning <u>October 1, 2009</u> April 1, 1995, a regional office of education advisory board shall be established within each region serving Class I counties <u>or within each group of regions participating in an intergovernmental agreement for the provision of professional development</u> to advise the regional superintendent of schools <u>of the region or regions involved</u> concerning the planning and delivery of <u>professional development</u> programs and services <u>under Section 2 3.62 and other programs under the control of the regional superintendent <u>of schools</u>.</u>

(b) The advisory board shall consist of <u>at least 9</u> the following 13 members. All members of the advisory board shall <u>be certified pursuant to Article 21 of this Code and be</u> <u>currently employed in positions requiring certification by a</u> <u>school district, special education cooperative, joint</u> <u>agreement, or regional office of education program. A majority</u> of members shall be nominated by statewide organizations representing teachers within the region or regions and selected by the regional superintendent of the region or regions involved. Administrators shall be nominated by statewide organizations representing administrators within the region or regions and selected by the regional superintendent of the region or regions involved.÷

(1) 7 public members, at least one from each county in the region, selected by the presidents of the region's school parent groups at a meeting held each April. Public members shall be geographically balanced throughout the region. Public members shall meet the same criteria as members of local boards of education but shall not be members of a local board of education or school district employees.

(2) 4 teachers, none of whom shall be from the same school district, nominated and selected by all the teachers in the region.

(3) 2 administrators, from different school districts, nominated and selected by all the administrators in the region.

Members of the advisory board shall serve 4-year terms, except that of the initial members, 5 shall serve until April 30, 1996, 4 shall serve until April 30, 1997, and 4 shall serve until April 30, 1998, as determined by lot.

(c) The regional office of education advisory board shall

meet at least <u>annually</u> <del>bi-monthly 6 times a year</del> for the performance of its advisory duties <del>under Section 3-11 and</del> <del>subsection (a) of this Section 3A-16.</del>
