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2020 School District Radon Report

Illinois State Board of Education December 14, 2020 Section 10-20.48 and 34-18.39 of the School Code (105 ILCS 5/10-20.48 and 105 ILCS 5/34-18.39)

Sections 10-20.48 and 34-18.39 of the School Code require the State Board of Education to report the results from all school districts that have performed radon tests to the General Assembly and Governor every two years. Attached are the testing results the State Board has received from November 2018 through November 2020.

The attachment indicates that 13 school districts submitted radon testing results for 71 schools or other facilities to either the State Board of Education or the Illinois Emergency Management Agency. The 71 facilities utilized 5,157 test kits to test for 4,465 rooms. The duplicate tests are set in the same location as another test to confirm the accuracy of the test kits that were used. Likewise, unopened blank tests are set and submitted for lab analysis along with all of the other test kits to verify that the lot of tests used didn't arrive from the supplier contaminated or already indicating the presence of radon.

The radon measurement results are reported in picoCurie per liter (pCi/L). A pCi/L is 2.22 atomic radon disintegrations per minute for each liter of air. The results of the radon measurements are interpreted to determine the need for additional testing and to assess the quality and confidence of the measurement data. Typically, follow-up measurements will be recommended in every room with results greater than 4.0 pCi/L in accordance with federal Environmental Protection Agency and Illinois Emergency Management Agency recommendations. Of the 4,465 rooms tested, 179 (3.47%) received test results greater than 4.0 pCi/L. St. Charles School District 303 was the only district that submitted retest results for its two facilities that tested greater than 4.0 pCi/L -- Fox Ridge Elementary School and the Transportation and Maintenance Building. Both facilities tested under 4.0 pCi/L when retested.

Attached is the Radon Testing Report for all facilities tested.
