RE: Report pursuant to 410 ILCS 45/12.1

Dear Members of the General Assembly:

The Office of the Attorney General is required pursuant to 410 ILCS 45/12.1 (P.A. 94-0879) to annually report to the General Assembly the number of lead poisoning cases that have been referred to the Office of the Attorney General by the Illinois Department of Public Health for enforcement due to violations of the Lead Poisoning Prevention Act (the "Act") or for failure to comply with a notice of deficiency and mitigation order issued pursuant to subsection (7) of Section 9 of the Act.

Please be advised that the Office of the Attorney General received one referral for enforcement for failure to comply with a notice of deficiency and mitigation order issued pursuant to subsection (7) of Section 9 of the Act, and one referral for an administrative inspection warrant to inspect for violations of the Act, from the Illinois Department of Public Health between January 1, 2022 and December 31, 2022.
