**SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 895**

WHEREAS, Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Incorporated, was founded on December 4, 1906 by seven college men, respectfully known as the Seven Jewels, on the campus of Cornell University in Ithaca, New York and became the first intercollegiate Greek-letter fraternity established by and for African Americans; and

WHEREAS, The Seven Jewels of the Fraternity, Henry Arthur Callis, Charles Henry Chapman, Eugene Kinckle Jones, George Biddle Kelley, Nathaniel Allison Murray, Robert Harold Ogle, and Vertner Woodson Tandy, recognized the need for a strong bond of brotherhood among African descendants in this country and the need to help correct the educational, economic, political, and social injustices faced by African Americans and other people of color; and

WHEREAS, Alpha Phi Alpha initially served as a study and support group for minority students who faced racial prejudice, both educationally and socially, at Cornell University; the founders and early leaders of the Fraternity succeeded in laying a firm foundation for Alpha Phi Alpha's principles of scholarship, fellowship, good character, and the uplifting of humanity; and

WHEREAS, While stressing academic excellence among its members since its founding, Alpha Phi Alpha has consistently supplied its voice and vision to the struggle of African Americans and people of color and to issues of civil rights around the world; and

WHEREAS, The aims of Alpha Phi Alpha are manly deeds, scholarship, and love for all mankind; and

WHEREAS, The mission of Alpha Phi Alpha is to develop leaders, promote brotherhood and academic excellence, and provide service and advocacy for communities, as exemplified through its national programs, which include "Go to High School, Go to College," a program focused on the educational achievement of students in elementary, secondary, and post-secondary schools that has given thousands of dollars in scholarship funds to deserving students, "Project Alpha," a program that teaches teenage pregnancy prevention and sexually transmitted disease prevention to young males, and the "A Voteless People is a Hopeless People" campaign, a voter registration and education program through which

thousands of voters have been educated and registered; the Fraternity also focuses on providing service through its strategic partnerships with Big Brothers Big Sisters, the Boy Scouts of America, the March of Dimes, the American Heart/American Stroke Association, and the American Cancer Society; and

WHEREAS, For over 115 years, Alpha Phi Alpha has played a fundamental role in the positive development of the character and education of more than 200,000 men around the world; and

WHEREAS, Alpha Phi Alpha has over 700 college and alumni chapters in the United States of America, Africa, Asia, the Caribbean, and Europe; this total includes 141 chapters in the Midwestern Region, including 32 in Illinois; its presence started in Illinois with the founding of the Theta Chapter in 1910, the first college chapter in Illinois, and the Xi Lambda Chapter in 1924, the first alumni chapter, both in Chicago; and

WHEREAS, Members of Alpha Phi Alpha include many noteworthy leaders in the areas of government, business, entertainment, science, and higher education, including Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., Thurgood Marshall, W.E.B. DuBois, John Hope Franklin, John H. Johnson, Adam Clayton Powell, Andrew Young, Robert Smith, and Cornel West; its membership also includes federal, State, and local elected officials, including U.S. Representative Danny K. Davis, former U.S. Senators Edward Brook and Roland Burris, former State Senator Donne E. Trotter, former State Representative Al Riley, former State Representative Art Turner Jr., former Cook County Board Presidents John and Todd Stroger, and former Mayor of Chicago Eugene Sawyer, among countless others who have long stood at the forefront of the fight for civil and human rights and social change for all Americans; and

WHEREAS, Several Alpha Phi Alpha members have served in the Illinois General Assembly; of the 102nd General Assembly, those members include Representative Justin Slaughter, Speaker of the House of Representatives Emanuel "Chris" Welch, and Senator Elgie R. Sims Jr., who also served as the 26th vice president of the Midwestern Region; and

WHEREAS, Alpha Phi Alpha continues to enrich the lives of its members, who, in turn, provide service and advocacy for the communities they serve; therefore, be it

WHEREAS, Tobacco smoke is a major contributor to indoor air pollution, and breathing secondhand smoke is a cause of disease and death, including heart disease, stroke, respiratory disease, lung cancer, low birth-weight babies, sudden infant death syndrome (SIDS), increased respiratory infections in children, asthma in children and adults, sinus cancer, and breast cancer in younger, premenopausal women; and

WHEREAS, The 2006 U.S. Surgeon General report, The Health Consequences of Involuntary Exposure to Tobacco Smoke, estimated that exposure to secondhand smoke kills approximately 50,000 people in the United States annually, including approximately 2,000 in Illinois; there is no risk-free level of exposure to secondhand smoke; ventilation and other air cleaning technologies cannot completely control for exposure of nonsmokers to secondhand smoke; smoke-free workplace policies are the only effective way to eliminate secondhand smoke exposure in the workplace, and evidence shows that smoke-free policies and laws do not have an adverse economic impact on the hospitality industry; and

WHEREAS, The Illinois Department of Public Health reported a 28.4 percent decline in the smoking rate after the Smoke Free Illinois Act (the Act) was enacted in 2008 in addition to a 4.1 percent and 1.4 percent decline in the mortality rate for heart disease and lung cancer, respectively; the number of callers to the Illinois Tobacco Quitline increased dramatically after the Act became law from 7,255 in 2006 to 24,575 in 2012; in 2011, 91 percent of adults reported no exposure to secondhand smoke in indoor public places, and 89% of Illinois adults believed policies not allowing tobacco use in indoor or outdoor public places should be strictly enforced; and

WHEREAS, Twenty-eight states and the District of Columbia have passed comprehensive smoke-free laws to protect people against the harmful effects of secondhand smoke; and

WHEREAS, Aerosol from electronic cigarettes has a high concentration of heavy metals, volatile organic compounds, and ultrafine particles; the particle concentration is higher than in conventional tobacco cigarette smoke; exposure to fine and ultrafine particles may exacerbate respiratory ailments like asthma and constrict arteries, which could trigger a heart attack; and

WHEREAS, The World Health Organization (WHO) recommends that electronic cigarettes not be used indoors, especially in smoke-free environments, in order to minimize the risk to bystanders of breathing in the aerosol emitted by the devices and to avoid undermining the enforcement of smoke-free laws; and

WHEREAS, Secondhand smoke from combusted marijuana contains many of the same toxins, irritants, and carcinogens as tobacco smoke that can be breathed deeply into the lungs, which can cause lung irritation and asthma attacks and makes respiratory infections more likely; exposure to fine particulate matter can exacerbate health problems, especially for people with respiratory conditions like asthma, bronchitis, or chronic obstructive pulmonary disease; research has shown that secondhand marijuana smoke can do as much damage to the heart and blood vessels as secondhand tobacco smoke; and

WHEREAS, The American Society for Heating, Refrigeration, and Air-Conditioning Engineers (ASHRAE), the standard setting body for the HVAC industry, affirms that mechanical solutions like ventilation cannot control for the health hazards of secondhand smoke, and its standard (62.1) for acceptable indoor air quality is based on an environment that is free from tobacco and marijuana smoke and secondhand aerosol from electronic cigarettes; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING HEREIN, that we strive to protect and strengthen the Smoke Free Illinois Act and urge the Illinois Department of Public Health to provide a data brief by 2023 on the impact of the Act since 2013 to commemorate the 15th anniversary of the Act's enactment; and be it further
