WHEREAS, There are many children whose birth families are unable to parent and give their children the care and love they deserve; and

WHEREAS, Adoption gives children and their adoptive parents a loving family environment, helping both find the nurturing family they deserve; and

WHEREAS, Adoptive parents make a powerful difference in the lives of their children by giving them a stable home and the love, attention, and guidance they need to prepare them for adulthood; and

WHEREAS, Birth parents, who make the difficult decision to place their children for adoption, deserve community support and respect; and

WHEREAS, Every successful adoption builds and strengthens Illinois' families, making our State a better place for all Illinoisans; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we designate November as National Adoption Awareness Month in the State of Illinois, highlighting the importance of adoption, drawing attention to the thousands of Illinois children awaiting a stable and loving home, and promoting public awareness of adoption and foster care.
