27. Consent Calendar. Senator Nedza, for what purpose do you
28. arise?

29. SENATOR NEDZA:

30. Thank you, Mr. President. I rise in order to ask leave
31. of the Body to discharge from committee Senate Bill 1013 for
32. the purposes of Tabling the bill.

33. PRESIDENT:

1. Which committee?

2. SENATOR NEDZA:

3. Appropriations.

4. PRESIDENT:

5. Alright. Senator Nedza seeks leave of the Body to dis-
6. charge the Committee on Appropriations from further consider-
7. ation of Senate Bill 1013 for the purpose of Tabling. Is
8. leave granted? Leave is granted. The bill is now discharged.
9. Senator Nedza now moves to Table Senate Bill 1013. All in
10. favor signify by saying Aye. All opposed. The Ayes have
11. it. So ordered. Senator Walsh, did you have a motion with
12. respect to House Bill 143? Senator Grotberg, for what purpose
13. do you arise?

14. SENATOR GROTEBERG:

15. On a point of personal privilege, Mr. President. While
16. there is a lull in the House, I thought it was...appropriate
17. to realize that the frustrations of the Legislature by the
18. Judicial process has again been brought into focus. I and
19. you, my colleagues in the Senate and House, have spent much
20. of our Legislative careers passing very constitutional laws
21. to guarantee that thousands of good State employees working
22. inside the walls of our State prisons would have the full
23. force of the law with them as they go about their daily work
24. in a very dangerous and violent setting. I speak of the
25. failure of the prosecution of the Pontiac rioters. My heart,
26. again, goes out to the families of the murder victims. It's
27. my intent to continue my efforts as a Legislator to find
28. statutory recognition for the giving of a life to the maniacs
29. under incarceration. And to statutorily give added adminis-
30. trative powers to the Department of Corrections and the
31. Courts to call off hopeless trials that benefit only the
32. attorneys all paid for...three or four million dollars of
33. the taxpayers' money of the taxpayers of Illinois. And

1. lastly, to begin once and for all, now, to build a small
2. maximum security prison to separate out the two to three
3. hundred murdering nuts from the general population of our
4. prisons. Yes, a garbage can for the rotten apples in the
5. general population is the only appropriate solution. Thank
6. you.

7. PRESIDENT:

8. Alright. With leave of the Body, if you'll turn to
9. page 56 on the Calendar...page 56 on the Calendar there are
10. two supplemental appropriation bills on the Order of House
11. Bills 2nd that I understand are of an emergency nature or at
12. least will be once they're properly amended. So the suggestion
13. has been made to the Chair that they be moved to the Order
14. of 3rd reading today with the understanding they will be
15. called back and amended tomorrow and sent on their way to

33. 2nd reading of the bill. No committee amendments.

1. PRESIDENT:

2. Any amendments from the Floor?

3. SECRETARY:

4. No Floor amendments.

5. PRESIDENT:

6. 3rd reading. Channel 20 has requested leave to...shoot
7. some film. Is leave granted? Leave is granted, with the
8. understanding that Mr. Smith will take the appropriate pictures.
9. ...Bloom, for what purpose do you arise?

10. SENATOR BLOOM:

11. Thank you, Mr. President. I rise for the purpose of
12. adding as a hyphenated co-sponsor to Senate Bill 1033, Senator
13. Demuzio. May I have leave?

15. You've heard the request. Is leave granted? Leave is
16. granted. If I can have your attention, there have been a

10. Weaver. Alright. Now it's up to the sponsor if they wish to
11. bring it back at this time, so we'll have to...all right on page
12. 47, middle of 47...23, Senator Lemke. No, it's not a question
13. of moving. You want to move it back for amendment is the
14. question. Alright. On the Order of Senate Bills 3rd reading,
15. Senate Bill 23. Senator Lemke seeks leave of the Body to
16. return Senate Bill 23 to the Order of 2nd reading for purposes

3. adds the word religion. There was a technical error in

22. titution shall be the sole disposition for a felon...felony

15. What does that amendment do?

16. PRESIDENT:

17. Senator Lemke.

18. SENATOR LEMKE:

19. What the amendment does, is very simple. It keeps the
20. length at sixty foot. The way the bill reads now there's no
21. length, but this keeps the length of the total tractor and
22. trailer at sixty foot.

23. PRESIDENT:

24. Further discussion? Senator Bloom.

25. SENATOR BLOOM:

26. Senator, would you be willing after this amendment is
27. put on and it's...advanced to 3rd to bring it back to 2nd
28. reading for another amendment?

29. SENATOR BLOOM:

30. Yeah. Okay. Thank you, Senator.

31. PRESIDENT:

1. Senator Lemke.

2. SENATOR LEMKE:

3. As long as you don't want to change the length and the
4. weight. I mean...if you're going to change the length and the
5. weight, I'm not going to bring it back, 'cause...you'll just
6. create a lot of problems. Or the height.

7. PRESIDENT:

8. Senator Bloom.

9. SENATOR BLOOM:

10. Obviously, Senator, I'd discuss the amendment with you
11. before I'd do that. Okay? Thank you.

12. PRESIDENT:

13. Alright. Senator Lemke has moved the adoption of Committee
14. Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 388. Any further discussion?
15. If not, all in favor signify by saying Aye. All opposed. The
16. Ayes have it. The amendment is adopted. Are there further
17. amendments?

18. SECRETARY:

19. No further committee amendments.

20. PRESIDENT:

21. Any amendments from the Floor?

22. SECRETARY:

23. No Floor amendments.

24. PRESIDENT:

25. 3rd reading. 390, Senator Vadalabene. On the Order of
26. Senate Bills 2nd reading, Senate Bill 390. Read the bill,
27. Mr. Secretary.

28. SECRETARY:

29. Senate Bill 390.

30. (Secretary reads title of bill)

31. 2nd reading of the bill. The Committee on Judiciary I offers
32. one amendment.

33. PRESIDENT:

1. Senator Vadalabene.

2. SENATOR VADALABENE:

3. Yes. Thank you, Mr. President and members of the Senate.
4. Committee Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 390, first, corrects
5. the incorrect numbering of the amended sections. Second, it
6. provides that the State shall have exclusive State power or
7. function, except in local governments whose population exceeds
8. five hundred thousand and in counties whose population exceeds
9. three million. And third, it has an effective date of January
10. 1, 1982 and I move for the adoption of Senate...of Amendment
11. No. 1 to Senate Bill 390.

12. PRESIDENT:

13. Senator Vadalabene has moved the adoption of Committee
14. Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 390. Any discussion? Senator
15. Ozinga.

16. SENATOR OZINGA:

17. Senator, this is the one that was agreed upon by...with
18. the Realtors from downstate?

19. PRESIDENT:

20. Senator Vadalabene.

21. SENATOR VADALABENE:

22. Yes. You are correct.

23. PRESIDENT:

24. Senator Ozinga.

25. SENATOR OZINGA:

26. This, for the information of the rest of the Body, was the
27. amendment that was asked for by the Realtors with a special
28. recognition of downstate cities. Is that right?

29. PRESIDENT:

30. Senator Vadalabene.

31. SENATOR VADALABENE:

32. Yes. That is correct.

33. PRESIDENT:

1. Alright. Senator Vadalabene has moved the adoption of
2. Committee Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 390. Any discussion?
3. Senator Netsch.

4. SENATOR NETSCH:

5. Thank you. I think it is more in the nature of a question.
6. As Senator Ozinga was just describing the amendment, he said
7. that it applied only to downstate cities. I think that is
8. not literally correct. If I heard the amendment correctly, it
9. ...excludes Chicago, but only Chicago, so that communities like
10. Evanston, Oak Park, etc., etc. would, also, be preempted from
11. condominium regulation under the terms of this bill with this
12. amendment on it. Is that correct, Senator Vadalabene?

13. PRESIDENT:

14. Senator Vadalabene.

15. SENATOR VADALABENE:

16. That is correct.

17. PRESIDENT:

18. Senator Netsch.

19. SENATOR NETSCH:

20. Alright. Well...the...that's a fairly important distinction.
21. We...appreciate giving us the opportunity to try to pass a
22. different form of condominium legislation, but I think some of
23. those Senate members who represent some of the other communities,
24. in fact I see Senator Berman waving his hand in recognition
25. right now, might want to take note of this, because their
26. own communities have some rather strong feelings about it.

27. PRESIDENT:

28. Any further discussion? Senator Ozinga.

29. SENATOR OZINGA:

30. Maybe it's a question of Senator Netsch, but we're just
31. wondering where etc. and etc. and etc. are. Are these the
32. one that she's talking about?

33. PRESIDENT:

1. Further discussion? Senator Vadalabene has moved the
2. adoption of Committee Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 390.
3. If there's no further discussion, all in favor signify by
4. saying Aye. All opposed. The Ayes have it. The amendment
5. is adopted. Are there further amendments?

6. SECRETARY:

7. No further committee amendments.

8. PRESIDENT:

9. Are there amendments from the Floor?

10. SECRETARY:

11. No Floor amendments.

12. PRESIDENT:

13. 3rd reading. Top of page 8, Senator Buzbee, 402. 406,
14. Senator Degnan. 407, who's handling that for Senator Donnewald?
