SENATOR JEREMIAH JOYCE:

Senator Mahar.

SENATOR MAHAR:

Thank you, Mr. President. I would move that Committee Amendment No. 1 be Tabled because the Committee Amendment No. 2 is the correct amendment.

Senator Vadalabene.

SENATOR VADALABENE:

Yes, thank you, Mr. President and members of the Senate. Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 122, this amendment is a proposal by IDOT for the ordinary land transfer in accordance with the current real estate law. It deletes everything after the enacting clause and rewrites the bill and authorizes IDOT to convey by quitclaim deed for the sum of thirty-six thousand two hundred and sixty-five dollars to the National Supermarkets, Incorporated for certain property, and I move for its adoption.

SENATOR ZITO:

Thank you, Mr. President. Asking for a sense of direction or advice from the Chair. I've been waiting for a fiscal note for about three weeks now, I have filed for it and would like to know what I'm supposed to do. I want to move the bill. It's from the Department of Revenue, Mr. President.

PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR SAVICKAS)

Yes, we're a...there is a mandated time on it that they must respond. If you'll wait one second. Senator, why don't we just pass it up for the time being, we'll get a hold of the department and get back to you.

SENATOR ZITO:

It was just a question of the Chair, thank you.

2nd reading of the bill. The Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Energy offers one amendment.

PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR SAVICKAS)

Senator Mahar.

SENATOR MAHAR:

Thank you, Mr. President. I would move to adopt Committee Amendment No. 1 which basically rewrites the bill. It

deals with the placarding of special waste hauling. I move for its adoption.

PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR SAVICKAS)

Senator Mahar. Senator Mahar moves the adoption of Committee Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 222. Those in favor indicate by saying Aye. Those opposed. The Ayes have it. Amendment No. 1 is adopted. Any further committee amendments?

PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR SAVICKAS)

3rd reading. Senate Bill 239, Senator Darrow. Senate Bill 245, Senator D'Arco. Senate Bill 250, Senator Lemke. Read the bill, Mr. Secretary.

SECRETARY:

Senate Bill 250.

(Secretary reads title of bill)

2nd reading of the bill. The Committee on Revenue offers five amendments.

PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR SAVICKAS)

Senator Lenke.

SENATOR LEMKE:

Okay, Amendment No. 1, what this does is deletes the provision allowing utilities to file their sales tax returns bimonthly or twice a month rather than quarterly, four times a month, as they are currently required to do. This would eliminate them getting a twenty-five million dollar windfall, and it's what the department had found that the requirement would make it a better bill. I ask for its adoption.

PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR SAVICKAS)

Is there further discussion? If not, Senator Lenke moves the adoption of...of Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 250. Those in favor indicate by saying Aye. Those opposed. The Ayes have it. Amendment No. 1 is adopted. Amendment No. 2, Senator Lenke.

SENATOR LEMKE:

What Amendment No. 2 does is that the disclaimer statement indicating that the State Legislature does not intend to expand any...in any way local sales tax base to include utility services.

PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR SAVICKAS)

Is there further discussion? If not, Senator Lenke moves the adoption of Amendment No. 2 to Senate Bill 250. Those in favor indicate by saying Aye. Those opposed. The Ayes have it. Amendment No. 2 is adopted. Amendment No. 3, Senator Lenke.

SENATOR LEMKE:

What Amendment No. 3 does is...is it makes a technical change in Senate Bill 250 to ensure that the taxable sale price does not include a local tax. In other words, this eliminates a tax on a tax. I ask for its adoption.

PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR SAVICKAS)

Is there further discussion? If not, Senator Lenke moves

the adoption of Amendment No. 3 to Senate Bill 250. Those in favor indicate by saying Aye. Those opposed. The Ayes have it. Amendment No. 3 is adopted. Any further amendments?

Senator Lenke.

SENATOR LEMKE:

What this amendment does is places utilities backs on the accelerated tax payment system with respects to retail or occupational tax, removes the special extension of time for filing the...the sales tax bond. It's another bill so the utility companies will not benefit. It eliminates the thirty-five million dollar windfall or loss of revenues to the State. I ask for its adoption.

PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR SAVICKAS)

Is there further discussion? If not, Senator Lenke moves the adoption of Amendment No. 4 to Senate Bill 250. Those in favor indicate by saying Aye. Those opposed. The Ayes have it. Amendment No. 4 is adopted. Any further amendments?

Senator Lenke.

SENATOR LEMKE:

This is a amendment that's is a technical amendment by the...Legislative Reference Bureau. It corrects some of the typographical error in the bill. I ask for its adoption.

PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR SAVICKAS)

Any further discussion? If not, Senator Lenke moves the adoption of Amendment No. 5 to Senate Bill 250. Those in favor indicate by saying Aye. Those opposed. The Ayes have it. Amendment No. 5 is adopted. Any further committee amendments?

Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH:

I'd like to ask the Secretary, is that the long amendment or is that the short amendment?

SECRETARY:

It is the long one.

SENATOR SMITH:

I'd like to have that one cancelled please, if I may, and I'd like to hear the short amendment.

PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR SAVICKAS)

Senator Smith moves to Table...Senator Smith withdraws Amendment No. 1. Now, are there further amendments?

SECRETARY:

Amendment No. 1 offered by Senator Smith.

PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR SAVICKAS)

Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH:

Thank you, Mr. President. This amendment provides that when mobile homes are concerned, the lot number of the mobile home shall appear on the voter's registration card. This amendment was suggested in the Elections and Reapportionment Committee. Since Senate Bill 285 is intended to eliminate confusion concerning the exact address of an elector, it was suggested that the same problem exists in large mobile home parks where one address is sometimes used for hundreds of person. I'd like to move the adoption of this amendment, sir.

PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR SAVICKAS)

Is there any discussion? If not, Senator Smith moves the adoption of Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 285. Those in favor indicate by saying Aye. Those opposed. The Ayes have it. Amendment No. 1 is adopted. Any further amendments?

Senator Vadalabene.

SENATOR VADALABENE:

Yes, thank you, Mr. President and members of the Senate.
In regard to Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 309, it removes
the Chicago Superintendent of Police and the director of the
Secretary of State from the provisions of the bill. And I
move for its adoption.

PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR SAVICKAS)

Is there further discussion? If not, Senator Vadalabene
moves the adoption of Committee Amendment No. 1 to Senate
Bill 309. Those in favor indicate by saying Aye. Those

SENATOR HUDSON:

Thank you, Mr. President. The Amendment No. 1 out of the...the committee amendment I am going...there was a...a technical error, these are really a couple of technical amendments I'm going to offer. But a technical error, a typo error, in that committee amendment which I can explain if...if necessary, but we...I am going to move to Table Committee Amendment No. 1 and replace that so that the...the amendment is in proper technical form.

PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR SAVICKAS)

Is there further discussion? If not, Senator Hudson moves to Table Committee Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 337. Those in favor indicate by saying Aye. Those opposed. The Ayes have it. The motion carries. Committee Amendment No. 1 is Tabled. Are there further amendments?

Amendment No. 2 offered by Senator Hudson. And, Senator Hudson, this is the small one, okay.

SENATOR HUDSON:

I would move, Mr. President, to adopt Amendment No. 2 which simply corrects the typographical error in the...the amendment that we Tabled.

PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR SAVICKAS)

Is there further discussion? Senator Rock.

SENATOR ROCK:

Pardon me, Mr. President and Ladies and Gentlemen. When you indicated the smaller one, there is only one that I am aware of, are there two more? One more?...can we read and find out which one we're talking about?

SECRETARY:

Talking about the one with LRB No. 8303241ESSBAM.

PRESIDING OFFICER: (SENATOR SAVICKAS)

Is that the one that was Tabled, Senator...Mr. Secretary? That's the one we're adopting right now. Senator Hudson, would you wish to explain it while...

SENATOR HUDSON:

Yes. Let's go back to the amendment that we Tabled. We Tabled it because what the Reference Bureau did was to replace the phrase, "a more than momentary," inserting instead of that, "sustained." This has to do with the life of the fetus. Now, they put sustained in all right and underlined it, but "More than momentary" was left without being struck. "more than momentary" should have been struck. So, that made amendment...the committee amendment technically incorrect. So, Amendment No. 2 that I'm now offering strikes "more than momentary," adding...replacing it with the word "sustained."
