Department of Human Services – Minimum Program Standards for Certification of Developmental Training (59 Ill. Adm. Code 116; 48 Ill. Reg. 14982)

Department of Human Services – Child Care (89 Ill. Adm. Code 50; 48 Ill. Reg. 9217)

Due to the appropriateness of the agency's response, no further action.

REVIEW OF AGENCY RULEMAKINGS

Rep. Tarver was added to the roll.

Department of Agriculture – Industrial Hemp Act (8 Ill. Adm. Code 1200; 47 Ill. Reg. 18778)

David Lakeman and Sam McGee represented the Department.

Discussion.

Sen. Harris moved, seconded by Sen. DeWitte, that JCAR, with the concurrence of the Department of Agriculture, extend the second notice period for this rulemaking for an additional 45 days. The motion passed unanimously (11-0-0).

Illinois Emergency Management Agency and Office of Homeland Security – Licensing of Radioactive Material (32 Ill. Adm. Code 330; 48 Ill. Reg. 10771)

Louise Conway represented the Agency and agreed to an Extension.

Rep. Haas moved, seconded by Rep. Reick, that JCAR, with the concurrence of the Illinois Emergency Management Agency and Office of Homeland Security, extend the second notice period for this rulemaking for an additional 45 days. The motion passed unanimously (11-0-0).

CERTIFICATION OF NO OBJECTION

Co-Chair Cunningham announced that no action will be taken on the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation rulemaking titled Medical Practice Act of 1987 (68 Ill. Adm. Code 1285; 47 Ill. Reg. 18265) and the Department of Human Services' peremptory rulemaking titled Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) (89 Ill. Adm. Code 121; 48 Ill. Reg. 14986). Those rulemakings will appear on JCAR's December Agenda.

Sen. Fowler moved, seconded by Rep. Tarver, that the Committee inform the agencies to whose rulemakings the Committee has not voted an Objection or Extension, or did not remove from the No Objection List, that the Committee considered their respective rulemakings at the monthly meeting and, based upon the Agreements for modification of the rulemaking made by the agency, no Objections will be issued. The motion passed unanimously (11-0-0).
