Illinois Regulation is a summary of the weekly regulatory decisions of State agencies published in the Illinois Register and action taken by the Illinois General Assembly's Joint Committee on Administrative Rules. Illinois Regulation, also titled The Flinn Report in memory of founding JCAR member Rep. Monroe Flinn, is designed to inform and involve the public in changes taking place in agency administration.

Adopted Rule

STATE RETIREMENT

The STATE EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM adopted amendments to The Administration and Operation of the State Employees' Retirement System of Illinois (80 IAC 1540; 45 III Reg 1464), effective 5/24/21, concerning resolution of mistakes in benefit calculation and eligibility for election to SERS Board seats. The rulemaking clarifies that benefit underpayments resulting from back pay awards can be addressed without action by the SERS Board: however, a member who believes SERS has incorrectly calculated the benefit or amount of underpayment still has right to appeal determination to the Board. The rulemaking also clarifies that currently employed SERS members qualify for election as Board trustees if they have attained 8 years of creditable service on or before the date they

are sworn into office as trustees. Retired SERS members qualify for election as "annuitants for at least 1 full year" if they have received at least 12 monthly pension annuity payments on or before the date they are sworn in as trustees.

Emergency Rulemaking

VEHICLE REGISTRATION

The SECRETARY OF STATE adopted emergency an amendment to Certificates of Title, Registration of Vehicles (92 IAC 1010; 45 III Reg 6862) effective 5/ 24/21, amending a previous emergency rule effective 5/6/21 for the remainder of its 150-day term. The previous emergency rule required all persons responsible for issuing, tracking and managing temporary registration permits (TRPs) to attend annual training. The emergency amendment clarifies that the annual training can be completed online and in-person training may be required if any violations occurred in the past year. Businesses that issue TRPs are affected.

■ Designates rules of special interest to small businesses, small municipalities, and not-for-profit corporations. Agencies are required to consider comments from these groups and minimize the regulatory burden on them.
