

Illinois Regulation is a summary of the weekly regulatory decisions of State agencies published in the Illinois Register and action taken by the Illinois General Assembly's Joint Committee on Administrative Rules. Illinois Regulation, also titled The Flinn Report in memory of founding JCAR member Rep. Monroe Flinn, is designed to inform and involve the public in changes taking place in agency administration.

Proposed Rulemakings

■ TAX APPEALS

The PROPERTY TAX APPEAL BOARD proposed amendments to the Part titled Practice and Procedure for Appeals Before the Property Tax Appeal Board (86 IAC 1910; 46 Ill Reg 17386) that authorize electronic filing of appeals and supporting evidence with the Property Tax Appeal Board via an electronic filing portal at its website. Appeals filed by attorneys must be filed electronically on or after 2/1/23 for residential appeals from Cook County; 5/1/23 for all other non-farm property appeals from Cook County; and 7/1/23 for all appeals statewide. Instructions for electronically filing various documents are included. The rulemaking also requires paper documents filed by a delivery service other than U.S. Mail to include a certificate of mailing indicating the date the delivery service took possession of the

document, which will be counted as the date of filing. Persons who have filed or will file cases before PTAB are affected by this rulemaking.

STATE TRAVEL

The DEPARTMENT OF CENTRAL MANAGEMENT SERVICES proposed an amendment to the Part titled The Travel Regulation Council (80 IAC 3000; 46 Ill Reg 17379) that updates (for the first time since 1995) the reimbursement schedule for per diem and meal allowances for State employees traveling on State business. Meal allowances for travel within Illinois are raised from \$5.50 to \$8.50 for breakfast,

\$5.50 to \$12.50 for lunch, and from \$17 to \$23 for dinner. The flat per diem rate (used in place of, not in addition to, meal allowances) is raised from \$7 to \$11 for each quarter of a day (6 hours) and from \$28 to \$44 for each full 24-hour day. For out of State travel, meal allowances and per diems are raised to \$9.50 for breakfast, \$13.50 for lunch, \$25 for dinner, \$12 per quarter of a day and \$48 per full day (currently, \$6.50 for breakfast or lunch, \$19 for dinner, \$8 per quarter day and \$32 per full day). Employees of State agencies whose travel reimbursements are regulated by a Travel Control Board are affected.

ADOPTED RULES: Rules adopted by agencies this week. **EMERGENCY RULES:** Adopted for a temporary period not to exceed 150 days.
PROPOSED RULES: Rules proposed by agencies this week, commencing a 45-day First Notice period during which public comments must be accepted.
PEREMPTORY RULES: Rules adopted without prior public notice or JCAR review as authorized by 5 ILCS 100/5-50.
■ Designates rules of special interest to small businesses, small municipalities, and not-for-profit corporations. Agencies are required to consider comments from these groups and minimize the regulatory burden on them.
