Heidi Poyer appeared on behalf of SBEL to answer questions from Sen. Turner. Discussion ensued.

Department of Financial and Professional Regulation - The Barber, Cosmetology, Esthetics, Hair Braiding, and Nail Technology Act of 1985 (68 Ill. Adm. Code 1175; 49 Ill. Reg. 01664)

Rep. Delgado moved, seconded by Rep. Tarver that JCAR, with the concurrence of the Department of Financial and Professional Regulation, extend the rulemaking titled The Barber, Cosmetology, Esthetics, Hair Braiding, and Nail Technology Act of 1985 (68 Ill. Adm. Code 1175; 49 Ill. Reg. 01664) for an additional 45 days.

The motion passed unanimously (9-0-0).

Department of Human Services - Early Intervention Program (89 Ill. Adm. Code 500; 49 Ill. Reg. 45)

Sen. Castro moved and Sen. DeWitte seconded, that JCAR recommend the Department of Human Services' follow its own rules, refrain from implementing changes to its fee collection policies outside of rule and also strive to reflect changes to its fee collection policies in rule in a more timely manner.

The motion passed unanimously (9-0-0).

CERTIFICATION OF NO OBJECTION

Co-Chair Cunningham announced that no action will be taken on the on the proposed rule found at Tab 1 from the Department of Children and Family Services titled Placement and Visitation Services (89 III. Adm. Code 301; 49 III. Reg. 3707) and the emergency rule found at Tab 24 from the Department of Healthcare and Family Services titled Special Eligibility Groups (Emergency) (89 III. Adm. Code 118; 49 III. Reg. 8261).

Rep. Vella moved, seconded by Rep. Delgado, that the Committee inform the agencies to whose rulemakings the Committee has not voted an Objection or Extension, or did not remove from the No Objection List, that the Committee considered their respective rulemakings at the monthly meeting and, based upon the Agreements for modification of the rulemaking made by the agency, no Objections will be issued. The motion passed unanimously (9-0-0).
