It looks like agreed to a memo by Reyes Kurson on March 25<sup>th</sup> responding to "Idea A" in Amy's e-mail of March 14<sup>th</sup>.

Baseline of 25 hours per month of legal work at \$400 per hour with an increase of a rate for Administrative hearings of their work at \$7500 per month rather than \$5000. (their claim is that their associate spends about 8 hours a week on administrative hearings.)

You have countered my request of 40 hours a month but that the administrative hearing hours of 15 would be essentially 15 of the 40. So, in my view after reading everything again, it is basically what agreed to on March 25<sup>th</sup> at 2:04. We have not really moved the ball.

I think I have read everything accurately. So, the question for you is can you increase the hours per month at a fee rate of \$400 without carving the administrative hearing hours as part of the 40? Can we guarantee 40 hours a month at \$400 an hour which would total 480 hours a year, plus an administrative retainer of \$7500 per month and then the renewable language we have both agreed to in the past?
