- Poe: "Yeah. Mr. Speaker, first of all, good news for the Illinois House, Representative Black is back. Excused absences today are Representatives Ryder, Tom Ryder, Schmitz, Pankau, Stephens, Bost, Durkin, Lindner, and Mathias."

Speaker Madigan: "Mr. Hartke."

Hartke: "Well, on the Democrat side we have Representative Murphy, Schoenberg, and Bradley excused absences."

Speaker Madigan: "On the Attendance Roll Call, Mr. Morrow."

- Morrow: "Thank you, Mr. Speaker. I got back yesterday in time to vote on Senate Bill 224, but somehow I was not recorded on the roll call, and I would like to be recorded as voting 'aye' on that Bill yesterday."
