Clerk Mahoney: "The House Perfunctory Session will come to order. Messages from the Governor to the honorable Members of the Illinois House of Representatives, 93rd General Assembly. Pursuant to Article IV, Section 9, subsection(b), of the Illinois Constitution of 1970, I hereby veto House Bills 956, 2981, 3957, 4475, 4651, 4960, 5131, 6740, 7029, 7030, and House Bill 7043. Sincerely, Rod R. Blagojevich, Governor of Illinois. Pursuant to Article IV, Section 9, subsection (c) (sic-(e))of the Illinois Constitution of 1970, I hereby return the following House Bills with my specific recommendations for change: House Bill 826, House Bill 2220, and House Bill 4992 with these changes, these House Bills will have my approval. I respectfully request your concurrence. Sincerely, Rod R. Blagojevich, Governor of Illinois. Introduction of House Bills-First Reading.
